## **Reminders/information**

School gates open at 8:30am and will close when children should be in class at 8:45am. This is when lessons start and the register is taken. The gates will be open again at 3:05pm for a 3:10pm finish for Reception children and a 3:15pm finish for all other year groups. Please try to be prompt in the mornings so that all opportunities for learning are able to be taken and in the afternoons by standing away from the building, close to the areas where your child will be released (the coloured areas on the email sent out on Thursday).



Please do NOT try to park in the back car park if picking children up from clubs or The Hub. This is a staff only car park as it is small and does not have much room to turn cars around.

ALSO please try NOT to drive down Timberdine Close in the mornings unless you have a parking permit for the school as there are not places to turn safely around. We have been asked to pass on that the NHS have had their entrances blocked and there have been some near misses with both children and vehicles, and, as a result, the community police officers will be doing some spot patrols.

#### Dear Parent/Carer,

Cherry Orchard Primary School is part of Operation Encompass, which is a national scheme that operates jointly between Educational and Early Years Settings, Police and Health.

Operation Encompass is a report that is generated by police and sent to the Education/ Early Years setting, when a child or young person has experienced domestic abuse.

As an Educational setting, we have ensured that a member of our staff, (Designated Safeguarding Lead), known as a Key Adult, has been trained in the Operation Encompass procedures allowing us to then use the information that has been shared, in confidence, to support the child/ren in our care.

The Domestic Abuse Act 2021 identifies children who experience domestic abuse as victims of domestic abuse in their own right.

We are keen to offer the best support possible to all the children in our care, and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.
