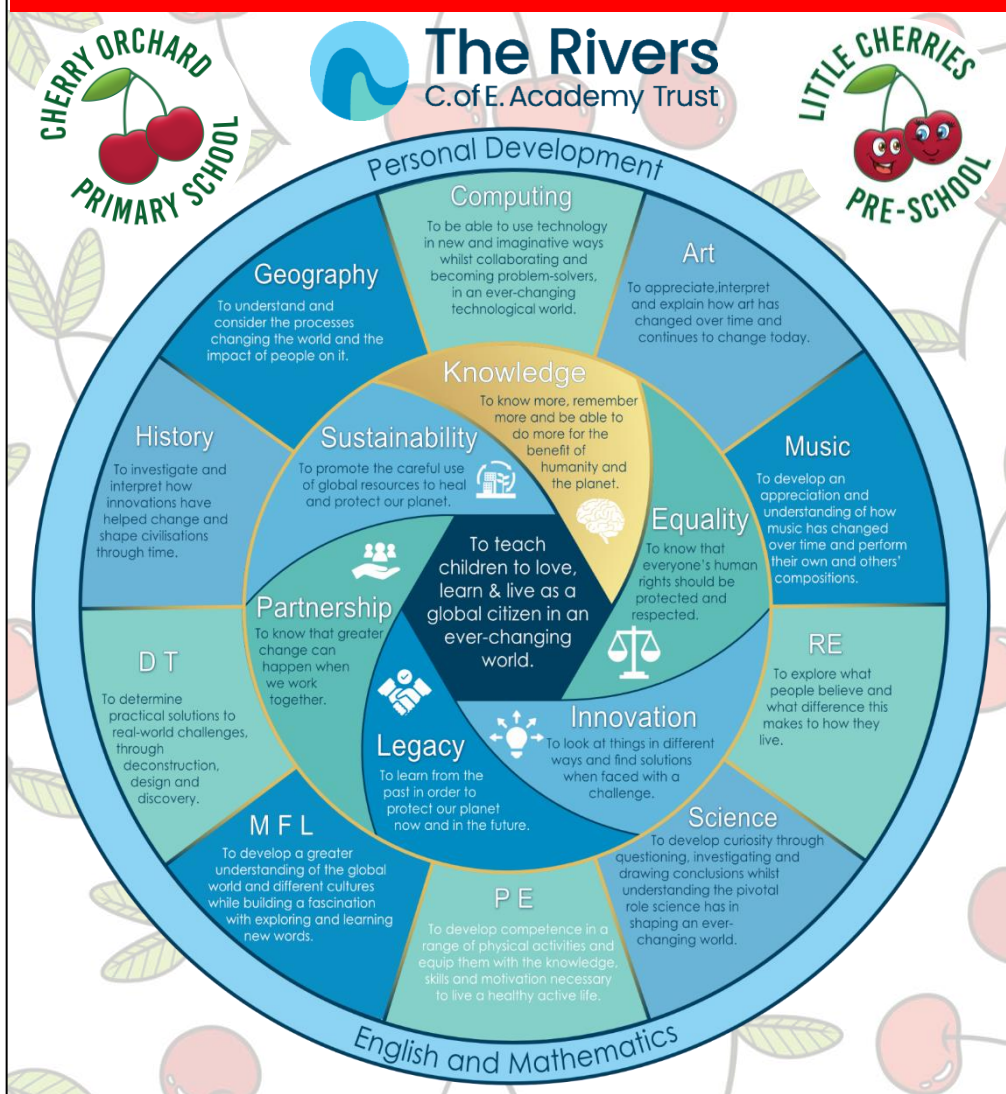

## PARENT/CARER'S AGREEMENT

To help my child at school, I will do my best to:

-  Make sure that my child attends regularly and is on time, gates open at 8.30am
-  Endeavour to avoid term time absence e.g. by not booking holidays or routine medical appointments during term time
-  Collect my child on time after school
-  Encourage my child to try hard, do all homework tasks, including regular reading and practice of times tables
-  See that my child wears the correct school uniform, including the P.E. kit, ensuring that it is all named
-  Contact the school by 9.00am, by phone or email, if my child is absent
-  Work with the school to try and make sure that my child behaves well and get in touch if there are problems at home that may affect my child's work and behaviour
