- Welcome to school:** Perform on stage in a Nativity, Start to learn to read with phonics, Transition though Stay and Play sessions, Begin learning journey through play and exploration at Nursery/Pre-School.

- Year 2:** Explore our local area as part of Geography, Write for real life purpose, Develop into independent readers, Experience history with a visit from Samuel Pepys, Take part in a drama workshop, Visit a synagogue, Learn about animals by visiting All Things Wild.
- Year 3:** Grow plants, Embed your love of reading, Go to the Swan Theatre to watch a pantomime, Perform at the Cathedral, Begin to learn a new language, Develop your historical knowledge with a visit from the History Man.
- Year 4:** Visit EnviroSort to find out about Recycling, Learn to swim, Discuss Hinduism with a visitor, Develop your knowledge of times tables, Spend a night away from home on residential, Explore art firsthand at Worcester Art Gallery.
- Year 5:** Learn to ride your bike safely (level 1), Explore the Iron Age with a visit to Bishops Wood, Explore The River Severn as part of our local area, Visit a mosque, Learn to ride your bike on the road safely (level 2), Perform at the Cathedral, Watch a performance of Shakespeare.
- Year 6:** Visit some high schools, Design a plate at Worcester Porcelain, Explore the history of our local area, Visit The Tudor House Museum, Put on a full-scale production, Formal exams, Transition days at High Schools, Design a box car and go to Shelsley Walsh to race it against other Rivers schools, Leave ready to take your learning onto the next stage.
