
Please try to discourage the bringing of toys/non-school items into school. They can go missing or get broken, meaning the children can get upset. Please keep them for home.



This week, year 3 have been learning new skills in our DT lesson.




We learnt to measure pieces of wood accurately, carefully cut them using a hacksaw, and then joined them using glue guns.


